

Updated New York State COVID-19 Travel Restrictions

As of November 4, 2020, all HASC students and staff must adhere to the updated New York State COVID-19 Travel Restrictions.

For out-of-state travel under 24 hours:

Any HASC student or staff member who travels out of New York State (*with the exception of travel to the contiguous states of New Jersey, Connecticut, Pennsylvania, Massachusetts, or Vermont*) for less than 24 hours does not need to quarantine or get COVID-19 testing upon return to New York State.

For out-of-state travel more than 24 hours:

Any HASC student or staff member who travels out of New York State (*with the exception of travel to the contiguous states of New Jersey, Connecticut, Pennsylvania, Massachusetts, or Vermont*) for more than 24 hours must quarantine for 14 days upon return to New York. However, there are new guidelines that allow travelers to “test-out” of the mandatory 14-day quarantine period. To “test-out”:

- The student or staff member must obtain a COVID-19 test within three days of departure from the state being visited
- Upon arrival in New York, the student or staff member must quarantine for three days.
- On day 4 of the quarantine period, the student or staff member must obtain another COVID-19 test. If both tests come back negative, the student or staff member may exit quarantine early and return to school.
- HASC requests a copy of the day-four negative COVID-19 test be presented school administration upon return to school.
