

HASC RE-OPENING PLAN SCHOOL YEAR 2021-2022

AMENDMENT DATE – SEPTEMBER 2021

Our centerbased instructional model is in-person at all sites, for all students and staff.

Advanced level Interns will be allowed to be on site if they are approved by the EMT and have completed all screenings and documentation. They must adhere to vaccination requirements for the site where they will be assigned.

HASC will participate in the snow pilot. HASC will inform parents and staff whether they will use a snow day **OR** provide remote learning in the event of a snowstorm, severe weather event or a catastrophic event in a building.

Daily temperature checks and questionnaire screening will not be done on site except where the county requires it to be done. Parents will screen children at home prior to attending school and keep children at home who are sick or show covid symptoms.

HASC will adhere to the DOH guidance of 7/6/21 of maintaining a 3-foot distance between students in classrooms. We will adopt DOH guidance to maintain a 6-foot distance between students in common areas, during lunch and in the gymnasium.

HASC will follow all quarantine mandates as per the CDC and NYSDOH and NYSED, based on vaccination status, social distancing, and masking.

ALL staff, independent contractors, parents, visitors, and repairmen **must** be vaccinated to be on site during instructional times at our Woodmere and 55th Street sites.

All staff, independent contractors and all others need to be either vaccinated or submit a negative PCR test on a weekly basis at our 63rd Street, and Rockland sites.
